- Newsletter blocks
- Render service

#### **Newsletter controller**

Includes the entity, repository and so on. It's the one who resolves the requests. Loads the editor, pick up the email template, defines the possible actions (copy, edit, show, etc) and establishes the model and db relationships.

Find it, as usual, by the name conventions: Controller/NewsletterController.php , Entity/NewsletterEntity.php , etc.
